Take 1-90 to Rt. 306. Go south 5 miles to Chardon Road (Rt. 6). Turn left (east) onto Chardon Road for 1 mile. Farmpark is on the right.

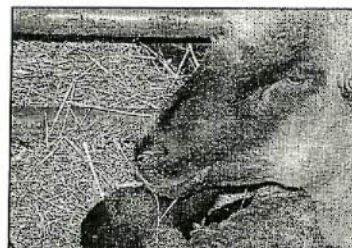

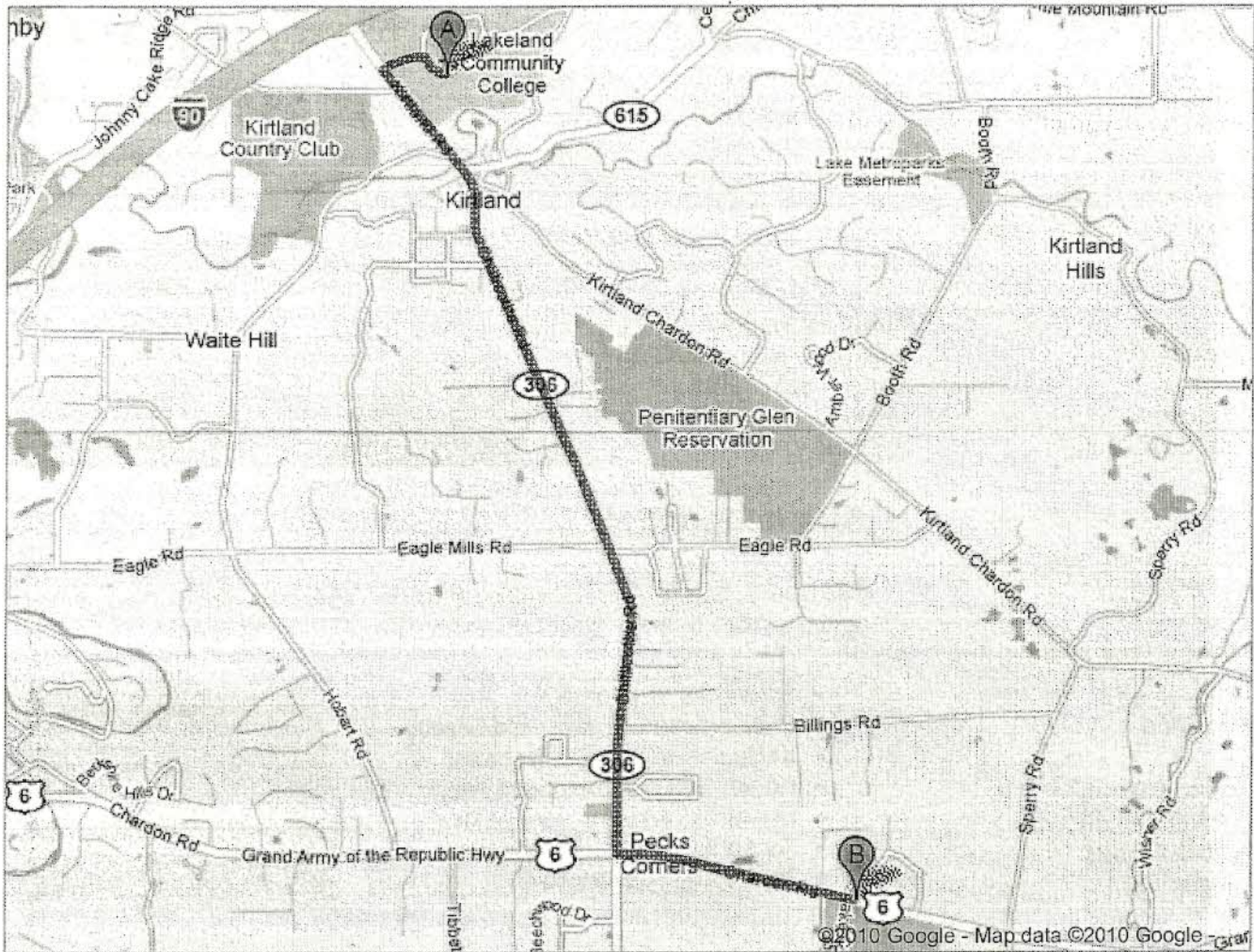

5. Turn **left** at **Chardon Rd** 1.1 mi
