This garden encompasses 25 acres of groupings of rhododendrons, azaleas, oaks, beeches and maples. While the bulk of flowering occurs in April, May and June makes this area a favorite destination for peaceful walks throughout the sun	
<b>Display Garden</b>	30

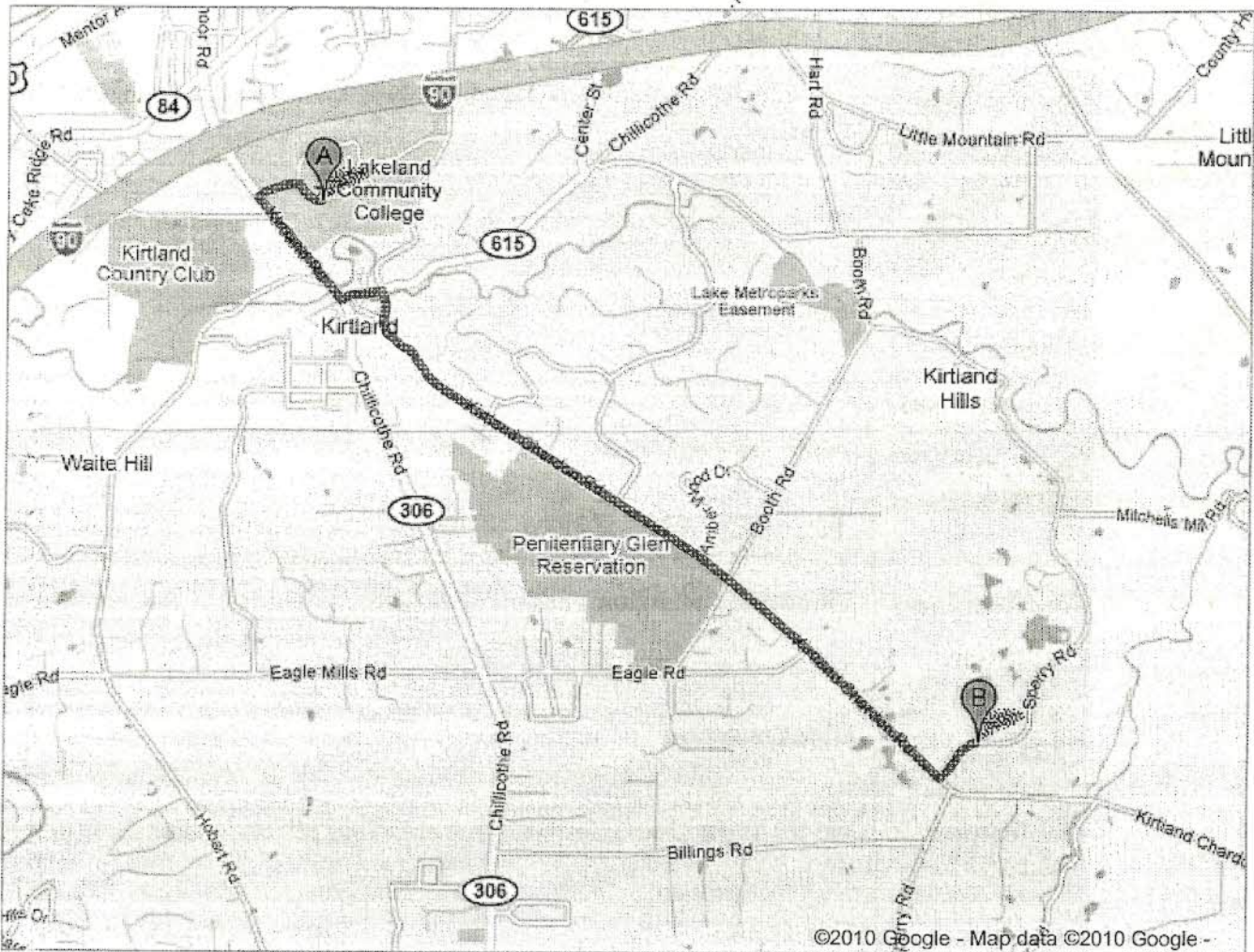
