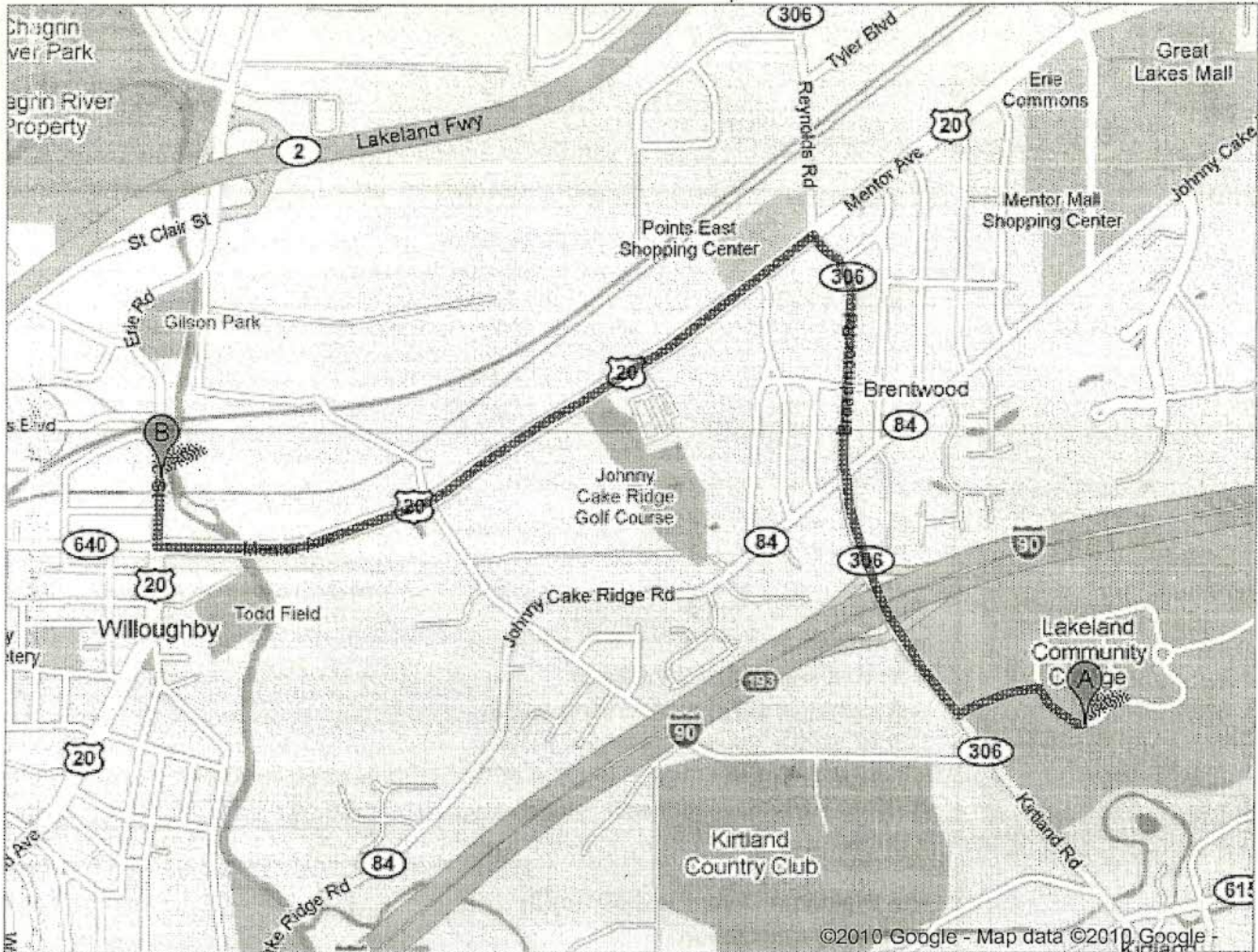

1. Head **west** on **Clocktower Dr** 0.1 mi
2. Take the 1st **left** to stay on **Clocktower Dr** 0.2 mi
3. Turn **right** at **Kirtland Rd/OH-306 N** 1.2 mi
 Continue to follow OH-306 N
4. Turn **left** at **Mentor Ave/US-20 W** 1.7 mi
5. Turn **right** at **Erie St** 0.2 mi
 Destination will be on the left
